If you find yourself lacking the time, money, or ability to take your dog to the groomer, knowing how to care for their coat at home is important. OR If you're tired of shelling out dollars for a groomer to give your dog a bath and a trim, and are considering the DIY route, first get informed about what your specific dog will need. Blow in the direction that the coat grows and brush in the same direction. This system would never be used on a poodle or breeds that need specialist treatment. It would make the coat crinkle and be hard to trim into shape. Instead you would separate each piece of hair as a hairdresser would do and blow into shape over a brush. Breeds that need a flat appearance like English Setters or Golden Retrievers should be brushed into shape as they dry.
